- We do receive lots of applications, so please be patient when waiting for a reply – we are a very small charity.
- Applications will be kept on file for 3 months. If we have been unable to match you up with a suitable cat during that time, you will need to reapply.
- It is rare that we have kittens, indoor only cats or pedigree cats looking for homes. The majority of cats who come into our care are older domestic shorthairs and longhairs who are used to, or need, outside access. We will only rehome to homes with young children (or other animals) if the cat has previously (and happily) lived with them.
- We generally only rehome within the Hampshire area – apart from in very rare and exceptional circumstances. We like to keep in touch with all of the animals that we rehome, so occasional follow up visits will need to take place after adoption.
- We offer lifetime rescue back up for all animals rehomed by St Francis Animal Welfare. If for any reason you are no longer able to keep a cat adopted from us – no matter how much time may have passed – then they will need to be returned to us. They must not be passed on to any 3<sup>rd</sup> party – without our full knowledge and written consent.
- All cats rehomed by us will be:  
Neutered or spayed (if too young, then we will provide a voucher for this for when they are old enough – this will be checked up on)  
Fully vaccinated,  
Vet checked,  
Wormed,  
De-flead,  
Assessed,  
Microchipped,  
Come with 5 weeks free pet insurance with Agria.
- There is an £80 minimum adoption fee for an adult cat and a £100 minimum adoption fee for a kitten, this is payable on the day that the adoption is completed.
