- We do receive lots of applications, so please be patient when waiting for a reply – we are a very small charity.
- Applications will be kept on file for 3 months. If we have been unable to match you up with a dog during that time, you will need to reapply.
- It is very rare that we have puppies looking for homes or pedigree dogs. The majority of dogs who come into our care are older mixed breeds. We will only rehome to homes with young children (or other animals) if the dog has previously (and happily) lived with them. For example, stray dogs will not be rehomed with children - due to their lack of history.
- We generally only rehome within the Hampshire area – apart from in very rare and very exceptional circumstances. We like to keep in touch with all of the animals that we rehome, so occasional follow up visits will need to take place after adoption.
- We offer lifetime rescue back up for all animals rehomed by St Francis Animal Welfare. If for any reason you are no longer able to keep a dog adopted from us – no matter how much time may have passed – then they will need to be returned to us. They must not be passed on to any 3rd party – without our full knowledge and written consent.
- All Dogs rehomed by us will be:
 - Neutered or spayed (if too young, then we will provide a voucher for this for when they are old enough – this will be checked up on)
 - Fully vaccinated,
 - Vet checked,
 - Wormed,
 - De-flead,
 - Assessed,
 - Microchipped,
 - Come with 5 weeks free pet insurance with Agria.
- The adoption fee varies depending on age and breed of the dog. This will be discussed following a successful application.
